1. HMHV Seminar Requirements (12 hours total)

- **Students must achieve a cumulative GPA of 3.00 or above** in all 21 hours submitted for the minor.
- 15 of the 21 hours for the minor must be upper division (300/400-level courses).

2. Distribution Requirements (9 hours total - all courses must be upper division, and at least 3 hours must be 400 level)
